Sometimes deciding which test to take can be stressful. Most advisors would recommend both assessments to see which one you feel more confident taking. Colleges accept both scores, so don't think one is "better" than the other. The link to the left is a breakdown of both assessments. This is a great resource to help understand the difference and get prepared for the exams.

The best way to decide which test is right for you, think about taking a free FULL- LENGTH, TIMED practice test. There are several online through Princeton Review, Kaplan, Khan Academy, just to name a few.

REGISTER FOR THE ACT OR SAT
To register for the ACT or SAT, students must register online. During the registration process, you will select the test date and testing location, which is most convenient for you.

*If you are a Junior or Senior and you qualify for free/reduced lunch, stop by Mrs. Black's office for an ACT or SAT waiver. You are eligible for 2 ACT and 2 SAT assessments for free. You can only take each test twice using waivers, so test wisely.
