

Sunlake High School - Student Council Application

Applications are due to Ms. E by 2:30 on Friday, April 26th with all required signatures.

Student Council is building traditions at Sunlake High School and serves as an outlet to develop student leadership. It is an honor to be part of Student Council because you are elected by your peers to represent their voices. Throughout the school year, all members are expected to maintain exemplary conduct and academic achievement. Therefore, a **3.0 weighted GPA** must be maintained throughout the year.

You will be involved in many diverse projects and activities that affect the school directly and indirectly. You will be expected to be an active member of your class and the school. Attending scheduled meetings and assigned activities or event held during or after school, is part of a member's responsibilities. The meeting schedule for the 2013-2014 school year will be Thursdays from 2:00pm-3:00pm. **MEETINGS ARE MANDATORY. You must be available for after school weekly meetings.** Although you may be an active member of other school organizations, you will still be expected to fulfill your duties of the office to which you are elected.

Election Process

Interested candidates will need to complete:

- an application with all required signatures by April 26, 2013
- A letter of intent (why you feel you are best suited for office) submitted with application
- A videotape of your speech to air on the morning news (this can be your letter of intent)
- A total of 10 community service hours to apply

Campaigning with flyers and posters

- You may campaign with flyers and posters posted on BULLETIN BOARDS as soon as your application is submitted to Ms. E
- Posters and flyers must be signed by an administrator for approval.

Voting will take place on Friday, May 3rd

Clean-up campaigning items will need to be completed by 3:00 pm May 6th.

- Members are to maintain a 3.0 weighted GPA throughout the 2013-2014 school year.
- Members are to attend 3 events each year. This number does not include meetings.
