The number of credits for the courses are shown in parentheses: **(0.5)** = ½ credit, semester class **(1.0)** = 1 credit, year-long class.

An asterisks symbol * indicates teacher approval is needed for the course via the MyStudent system after the courses are requested by the student.

A number one symbol 1 indicates that it is a Dual Enrollment course and the student must apply for and meet the Dual Enrollment requirements.

A degree symbol ° indicates an **Advanced Placement (AP)** course with a required AP Exam in May. Students who successfully complete 4 AP courses and exams plus the two AP Capstone courses will receive an AP Capstone Diploma when they graduate.

A hashtag symbol # indicates a course that gives **Performing/Fine/Practical Arts credit** (1.0 credit required for graduation).
