Parking Information and Policies

To receive a parking tag, the student must have and submit:

- A **signed policy sheet**
- A complete **vehicle application**
- The **\$30 parking fee** paid in full
- Completion of the “**Safe Behind the Wheel**” driving course. (Students **must** take this class if they have not already done so.)
- Visual confirmation of the **insurance policy card** under which he student is covered.
- Visual confirmation of a **valid driver’s license**
- A **2.0 Grade Point Average** (as verified by the SLHS administration)
- Eligible attendance records (as verified by the SLHS administration)

By initialing at each line, you are acknowledging and agreeing to Sunlake’s Student Parking Policy.

_____ Parking registration fees are non-refundable.

_____ Under reasonable suspicion, a vehicle may be searched for weapons, drugs, or other items, which are illegal, or against School Board Policy, e.g., alcohol, stolen property, or other contraband.

_____ If any of the above listed things are found in the car, appropriate legal action will be taken and the parking permit will be revoked.

_____ Vehicles not displaying a parking tag, or those that are inappropriately or illegally parked so as to cause a safety hazard, may be warned, booted or towed at the owners’ expense.

_____ Students who drive inappropriately or dangerously are subject to having their parking privileges suspended or revoked.

_____ There will be no refunds for lost hang tags/parking privileges. Students who lose their parking passes must purchase another for the price of \$5.00.

_____ Students must vacate the parking lot by 2:30, unless they are participating in a co-curricular activity.

_____ Students who arrive after 2nd period begins, or leave prior to the start of 7th period, will need to park in the front lot in the two rows closest to Sunlake Blvd, and must show the appropriate parking tag.

_____ Parking lot gates are closed and locked from the start of second period to the end of 6th period.

_____ Students are not permitted to go to their vehicle during the school day.

_____ Parking on campus is a privilege. This privilege may be revoked due to attendance and discipline referrals.
