

Lord of the Flies Summer Reading Assignment

Welcome to Mrs. LeBlanc's English IV Honors class. I hope all of you have a relaxing and enjoyable summer. Your summer reading assignment is to first read the novel and then respond to it in the following manner:

Choose a significant scene from the novel and rewrite it from the perspective of one of the characters present. This means you will write it in the first person (using I, me, my, etc.). It should be written like a story and include appropriate descriptions and dialogue. Your scene should be between 500 and 600 words and be double spaced.

Choose twenty to twenty-five words that are unfamiliar to you and define them in the following way:

1. List each word and its part of speech.
2. Give the best definition of the word based on how it is used in the text (Cite where you get your definition! Do NOT just Googlesearch the word and write down the first definition!)
3. Type the sentence in which the word is used as well as the page number.

- Type this your response to this assignment in Times New Roman, 12pt font.
- Use MLA format for your heading. Don't forget to number your pages in MLA style.
- Both content and grammar will be counted in the grade you earn.
- Please be sure that you properly give credit to any work that is not your own (like dictionary definitions)
