<b>Question:</b> Answer:	Is the orientation mandatory? Yes, effective Fall semester 2019 (20201), all dual enrollment students must successfully complete the Dual Enrollment Online Orientation.
<b>Question:</b> Answer:	<b>Can I register without completing the orientation?</b> Dual enrollment students will not be permitted to register until the Dual Enrollment Online Orientation course has been completed and the hold removed.
<b>Question:</b> Answer:	How can I sign up? All new and continuing dual enrollment students who have completed the Online Dual Enrollment application will be automatically enrolled in this course.
<b>Question:</b> Answer:	When will the Dual Enrollment Student Orientation hold be removed? The Dual Enrollment Online Orientation hold will be removed automatically. However, please allow approximately three hours for the hold to be removed.
<b>Question:</b> Answer:	Where can I find this orientation? The Dual Enrollment Online Orientation course is located via the myPHSC portal in the Canvas learning platform.
Question:	How do I access the Canvas learning platform?

Question:	How long does the orientation take?

Answer: It varies, of course, but you should be able to complete it in 2 hours. At the end of each module, you will have to take a quiz, and you must achieve 100% before you can move on to the next module. So, don't just scan the information – it might be in a question at the end!

## Question: Do I have to complete the orientation in one sitting?

Answer: No. You may complete the course in one sitting, or come and go from the course – even over several days. The modules you've completed will be saved, so you can pick up where you left off.

## Question: What if I don't score 80% or higher on the final assessment?

Answer: You may take the assessment as many times as you need to reach the 80% required. You may also go back into the course to review areas as needed.
