Sunlake High School's Prom policy allows an SLHS student to bring one guest. Guests may not be middle school students or anyone over the age of 19 years.

To be considered, a guest must submit this guest agreement. Guest agreements are due by Friday, April 24th, 2026.

This application must be filled out in its entirety and requires signatures of the SLHS student, the SLHS student's parent/guardian, the guest, the guest's parent/guardian and **the signature of an administrator of the guest's high school**. Additionally, **a clear copy of a valid driver's license or photo ID of the guest must be attached**. All guest applications are subject to approval or non-approval by the SLHS principal or designee. Providing false information on this application will result in the request being denied. All tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.

- NO REFUNDS** I understand that there will be no refunds given once a Prom ticket is purchased.
- NON-TRANSFERABLE** I understand that a ticket has been purchased for me to be a guest of an SLHS student and only I will be permitted to use this ticket that has been purchased for me. I understand that I am not permitted to give or sell my ticket to another student to use if I choose to no longer attend.
- IDENTIFICATION** I understand I must provide one of the following in order to gain admittance to Prom: a 25-26 school ID, a valid driver's license, or a government issued ID (passport, etc.).
- ARRIVAL** I understand the doors to Prom will be closed at 8:00 pm and any student arriving **after 8:00 pm will NOT be granted admittance.**
- NO RE-ENTRY** There will be no re-entry to Homecoming. I understand any student who leaves the event will not be permitted to re-enter the dance.
- END OF PROM** I understand I must be picked up by 11:15 pm or earlier.

BEHAVIOR AND POLICIES:

- Warnings concerning violation of these expectations will NOT be given. NO refunds will be issued to any student/guest asked to leave.**
- The SLHS Prom is a Pasco County School sanctioned event; therefore, all rules, policies, and procedures outlined in the Pasco Student Code of Conduct will be enforced.
- All attendees and guests must abide by the rules in a respectable manner both on and off the dance floor.
- Dancing that is deemed sexually lewd or suggestive in any form or any behavior deemed to break the Pasco County Student Code of Conduct will not be tolerated and **will result in immediate removal** from the dance.
- Students, their belongings and/or vehicles, including party buses, limousines and personal vehicles may be searched upon reasonable suspicion of illegal substances including, but not limited to drugs, alcohol, or vapes.
- Any student or guest under the influence or in possession of any illegal substances, including, but not limited to alcohol, drugs, or tobacco will be referred to local law enforcement and Pasco students can receive up to 10 (ten) days out-of-school suspension.
- If a student or guest violates any of the above listed terms, the parent/guardian(s) will be contacted and students must leave school property immediately.
- If a student or guest is suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol, parents must immediately pick up the student from the dance.**

DRESS CODE FOR ALL STUDENTS/GUESTS

- Students will not be admitted wearing jeans/denim, sheer fabric, shorts, cargo pants, t-shirts, flip-flops, torn clothing, chains/spikes, bandanas, or items referencing tobacco or alcohol products.
- All students must wear clothing that has fabric in the front, back, and on the sides (under the arms) and shoes.
- All clothing must cover undergarments, including straps and waistbands. Fabric covering chests, genitals, and buttocks must be opaque.
- Dress pants are required. Tuxedos, suits, and khakis are permitted. Pants must be secured around the waist at all times.
- Dress shirts must be worn at all times and may not be removed. Dress shirts that are semi-transparent require an undershirt.
- Dress length and/or slits should not reveal the leg more than 4 inches above the knee.
- The back of the dress should fall above the natural hipline, with sufficient coverage. The neckline of the dress should have suitable coverage.
- The Principal's/Administrator's decision on a student's violation of dress code is final and may not be appealed.
- If you are uncertain if your outfit meets the dress code, please send a picture of yourself in the outfit to your guest so he/she can show a Sunlake administrator prior to the event.**
- Students dressed inappropriately will be turned away at the door and no refund will be issued.
